Collection Report

Collection Better!! Last Sunday's collection came to \$4,083. We thank those who are conscientious about making up for missed Sundays.

Interesting

Of the above amount, \$2,961 came in cash, the rest in checks. \$1,026 came in single dollar bills. Of this, \$226 came in envelopes, usually with more than a single dollar. That left \$800 in loose singles. Granted that some parishioners must certainly have made their contribution by depositing two or more singles, it seems probable that many continue to judge a dollar to be enough to spare their parish.

On the Other Hand:

We must thank the 100 parishioners who gave \$5, the 50 who gave \$10 and the 35 who gave \$20, once again granted that there are those who may have contributed two or bigger bills and that our count of donors cannot be exact. (Here we are not considering those who wrote checks. We will offer a breakdown of that category in the near future.)

Latin America & Home Missions

This weekend we take up the second collection for both the home missions here in the United States and for the Church in Latin America. The proceeds will fund catechetical programs, marriage and family life programs and the formation of seminarians. The support you give today will make a difference for years to come.

We have had only a few requests for memorial bricks in the chapel garden. If we do not receive at least ten requests by September we plan to return any contributions already made. Meanwhile it is still possible to inscribe a paving brick in memory of a deceased loved one or in tribute to the living. The donation is \$200. Since we can install the bricks only if we have a minimum order of ten, we encourage anyone interested to register as soon as possible. There is always a long delay between submitting the order and the installation date and we would like to be able to do so early in the summer. Enrollment forms are available both in the rectory office.

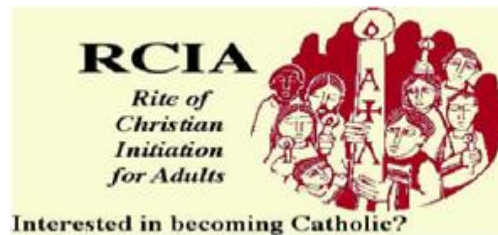
