RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION**Children grades 1 to HS:**

Registration and re-registration takes place from Tuesday to Friday 11am to 6:30pm in the rectory during regular office hours. *Also, from 8am to 2pm on the following Sundays: August 30, September 6, and 13.*

One (1) child: \$70

Two (2) children: \$100

Three or more (3+) children: \$130

Baptismal certificates are necessary for children already baptized, otherwise a birth certificate.

There is always a long delay between submitting the order and the installation date and we would like to be able to do so early in the summer. 54 Day Rosary Novena

As a message of hope in response to the spiritual crisis in our culture and nation, all are being urged to participate in the saying of the rosary daily from August 15, the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary, through October 7, the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. The prayers would be offered for marriage and the family, for peace, for human life and for freedom. The daily rosary might be recited individually, as a family or with a parish group, for 54 straight days, 27 days in petition from August 15 through September 10, and then 27 days in thanksgiving from September 11 through October 7.
