Living Faith Now

In order to be a Christian in the Catholic Church, it is necessary to receive the three sacraments of initiation: baptism, confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. If you have not received one of them, you are not completely initiated into the faith and for that reason you cannot exercise a public ministry such as the priesthood, or live a consecrated life as a nun, monk, friar, or missionary. Some insist that if you are not confirmed, you cannot be married by the Church. Nevertheless, we know that, for different reasons, there are Christians who have not had the opportunity to be confirmed but desire to exercise the ministry of matrimony. For that reason, canon law does not deny marriage, but does insist that Christians who wish to be married by the Church should seek a way to be confirmed if it is possible without serious difficulty (Canon 1065). We all know baptism and Eucharist, but what is confirmation? The name says it all. With confirmation, we confirm before God, the Church, and the world that we desire to be Christians for the rest of our lives. To be confirmed is to commit and to dedicate ourselves to God's service by helping our neighbors through the grace and power of the Holy Spirit. Therefore, it is important to receive good preparation. The majority of us did not have an option when we were baptized. Our parents and godparents said "yes" for us, and if they complied with their commitment, they taught us with words and good example to say "yes" to the Gospel of Christ. Whether we are baptized as infants or as adults, confirmation gives us the opportunity to give our own resounding "yes" to our baptism, "yes" to the Church, and "yes" to Christ.
