**Memorial Garden: Subscriptions Slow**

We have had only a few requests for memorial bricks in the chapel garden. If we do not receive at least ten requests by September we plan to return any contributions already made. Meanwhile it is still possible to inscribe a paving brick in memory of a deceased loved one or in tribute to the living. The donation is \$200. Since we can install the bricks only if we have a minimum order of ten, we encourage anyone interested to register as soon as possible. There is always a long delay between submitting the order and the installation date and we would like to be able to do so early in the summer. Enrollment forms are available both in the rectory office.

**Cremation**

For many years the Catholic Church prohibited cremation not because it was in itself wrong but because it had at one time been promoted as a way of denying the doctrine of the resurrection of the body. It is now permitted but full-body burial is still considered preferable. It is becoming increasingly more common, mainly for economic reasons. Catholics, however, should keep in mind that it is of the utmost importance, if we are to maintain reverence for the human body, that the ashes of the dead not be treated as are other objects, even the most prized. The remains of the dead should be permanently interred, whether in the ground or in a crypt, tomb or mausoleum. Ashes should not be kept at home, no matter how decorative the urn and regardless of sentiment, and they should not be worn as jewelry. There is a great difference between sentiment, however admirable, and Christian faith. Our faith makes it incumbent upon us to maintain a sense that the human body and its remains are sacred. To give the remains of the dead a special place is to preserve a sense that the dead, having definitively left this earthly realm, have entered –such is our hope – another realm entirely, that of God. They no longer belong to us, they are entrusted to Him.

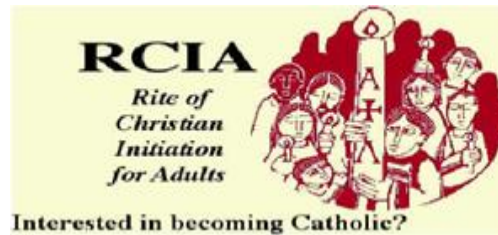
